

The University is in process of allotting hostel to the students of the various Departments, as the offline on campus classes have started as per the instructions of the Punjab Government. As per the current situation, only about 600 slots are available in all the hostels for incoming and new students. According to the COVID-19 guidelines issued by the State Government, every student is to be provided with a separate accommodation. It is anticipated that the number of students willing to take accommodation in the hostels is going to be much more than the available slots. As per the directions of the competent authority, it has been decided that the students are to be allocated the accommodation in the hostels based upon the criterion of distance of the place of their residence from the Guru Nanak Dev University Campus i.e. the student living farthest from the Campus will be given preference.

All the Heads are, therefore, requested that in order to facilitate the implementation of this order, the students of their respective Departments be directed to **apply** through university website portal indicating their place of residence alongwith the distance between the University Campus and place of their residence, by 18.12.2020.

The students should be instructed to ensure the authenticity of the information regarding the distance between the University Campus and place of their residence. This information will also be certified by the Head of the Department before allocation of the hostel accommodation. In case of any false information, the student will be debarred from the claim of hostel.
