About Guru Nanak Dev University

Guru Nanak Dev University was established at Amritsar, India on November 24, 1969 to commemorate Guru Nanak Dev's birth quincentenary celebrations. The university has marked its emblem across the globe and is continuing its journey of achieving new heights in pursuance of its cherished goals. University Grants Commission (UGC) has granted category -1 status to the university, the only university to get this ELITE STATUS in the region of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh & Chandigarh. Improving its rank from last year, Guru Nanak Dev University has been ranked 59 in the All - India university ranking released under the national institution ranking framework (NIRF) by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India. Under swachh campus ranking 2018 of higher educational institutions university got 2nd rank at national level amongst the cleanest higher educational institution in the country in the category of government universities. The University is ranked as one of the top universities in North India with a score of 3.51 on a 4 point scale by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (accredited at highest level i.e. A++ as per the new modified criteria) and it has also been conferred with potential for excellence (UPE) by UGC and is amongst 16 universities in the country to be bestowed this status. The MHRD has also released a grant of Rs. 107 crore for modernizing the main campus of Guru Nanak Dev University. This year again the university has won the highest sports award in the country, the Maulana AbulKalam Azad Trophy, for a record of 23 times.

About School of Education

The School of Education (SOE) forms the main backbone of integrated development of teachers. By setting up a School of Education, the university intends to strengthen the holistic vision for teacher education in the state, keeping it intimately connected with school education. This would in turn support and enable professional development, research collaboration, school interventions, curricular resource development and state academic planning. Keeping in view the present context of educational settings, the SOE offers academic programmes in education as an area of knowledge and field of professional practice. The SOE will focus on engaging teachers/scholars in educational discourses and knowledge generation. It will also provide avenues for professional development of teachers, teacher educators and other educational functionaries. The SOE endeavors to provide programmes of excellence in the pre-service and in-service education of prospective and practicing teachers through teaching and learning, research, consultancy, publication and community services.

Focus of the Seminar

Keeping in line with the mission of PMMMNMTT scheme, the national seminar is an initiative to stimulate educators on ensuring Inclusive and equitable quality education. Education is central to the underlying intentions of the United Nations sustainable development goals (The global education 2030 Agenda, UNESCO). The different policies are adapting to bring change in existing system for fulfillment of predetermined objectives of quality education If we are to realize the ambition of an inclusive and equitable world, what we need to do is completely rethink the whole concept of education. Education is the key that will allow many other sustainable development goals to be achieved. Hence, teachers should also nurture their classroom spaces as places where children can learn freely. This seminar aims to spark a dialogue among all stakeholders and promote increased understanding of how to develop the culture of inclusive and equitable quality education in a challenging context of learning.
