वाइस चांसलर प्रो. जसपाल सिंह संधू ने कहा कि इस समझौते के कारण यूनिवर्सिटी के अध्यापन और गैर-अध्यापन कर्मचारियों को यू.जी.सी. दिशा निर्देश ऑनलाइन, ओपन डिस्टेंस लर्निंग और मूक के द्वारा पढ़ाने के लिए लैक्चर व अन्य संबंधित सामग्री तैयार करने के लिए ट्रेनिंग दी जाएगी। इसके साथ विद्यार्थियों को आधुनिक तकनीक द्वारा उच्च शिक्षा देने के हर संभव प्रयास किए जाएंगे। मल्टीमीडिया द्वारा विद्यार्थियों की रुचि को ध्यान में रखते हुए पढ़ाने की सामग्री तैयार की जाएगी।

डा. जे.वी. नड्डा ने उच्च शिक्षा में आधुनिक तकनीकों का प्रयोग संबंधी एक शार्ट फिल्म दिखाते हुए बताया कि विश्व में महामारी कोविड करके उच्च शिक्षा विशेष कर प्रभावित हुई है, परंतु इन तकनीकों द्वारा प्रयास किए गए हैं कि विद्यार्थियों को अधिक से अधिक उच्च शिक्षा उपलब्ध की जाए। मानवीय स्रोत और विकास मंत्रालय द्वारा मूक आनलाइन प्लेटफॉर्म

द्वारा 32 उच्च शिक्षा से संबंधित चैनल चलाए जा रहे हैं, ताकि विद्यार्थियों को घर बैठे ही इंटरनेट के जरिए ज्ञान हासिल हो सके। उन्होंने आशा अभिव्यक्ति कि यह समझौता दोनों अदरों के लिए लाभपरक साबित होगा। रजिस्ट्रार प्रो. काहलों ने यूनिवर्सिटी में चल रहे अलग अलग कोर्सों बारे जानकारी दी।

प्रो. बेदी ने कहा कि सी.ई.सी. जैसे अदरों के साथ समझौता करना यूनिवर्सिटी के लिए एक गर्व की बात है और इस के जरिए दोनों अदरों मिल कर देश की उच्च शिक्षा संबंधी कार्य करेंगे।
