अमृतसर, 28 जून (स.ह.): गुरु नानक देव यूनिवर्सिटी और यूनिवर्सिटी ग्रांट्स कमीशन इंटर-यूनिवर्सिटी सेंटर के कौसोरिटियम फॉर एजुकेशनल कम्यूनिकेशन (सी.ई.सी.) में आज यहां एक महत्वपूर्ण समझौता कल मबद्दल किया गया।

इस समझौते अधीन उच्च शिक्षा को आज के माहौल की जरूरतों को ध्यान में रखते हुए पोस्ट-ग्रीजुएट और अंडर-ग्रीजुएट क्षात्रों संबंधी आधुनिक टक्कालॉजी का प्रयोग करते पढ़ने-पढ़ने के तौर तरीकों पर दोनों अदारे ने मिल कर कार्य करेंगे।

द्वारा 32 उच्च शिक्षा से संबंधित चैनल चलाए जा रहे हैं, ताकि विद्यार्थियों को घर बैठे ही इंटरनेट के जरिए ज्ञान हासिल हो सके। उन्होंने आशा अभिव्यक्ति कि यह समझौता दोनों अदारों के लिए लाभपरक साबित होगा। रजिस्ट्रार प्रो. काहलों ने यूनिवर्सिटी में चल रहे अलग अलग कोर्सों बारे जानकारी दी।

प्रो. बेदी ने कहा कि सी.ई.सी जैसे अदारों के साथ समझौता करना यूनिवर्सिटी के लिए एक गर्व की बात है और इस के जरिए दोनों अदारे मिल कर देश की उच्च शिक्षा संबंधी कार्य करेंगे।
