INSTRUCTIONS/GUIDELINES FOR THEORY AND PRACTICAL TEST FOR THE POST OF JUNIOR TECHNICIAN IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

1. There will be Theory and Practical Test for the Post of Junior Technician (Agriculture).
2. The Distribution of marks will be as under :-

Theory	-	70marks
Practical	-	30 marks
3. The theory paper shall be of one hour duration and consist of 70 multiple choice questions having one mark each.
4. There shall be no negative marking.
5. To pass the Theory and Practical Test, candidates will have to obtain at least 50% marks in Theory and Practical Test separately. Only those candidates will be called for practical test, who obtain a minimum of 50% marks in theory test. Similarly, only those candidates will be included in the merit list, who obtain a minimum of 50% marks in the practical test. However, the final merit will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate in theory and practical tests.
6. The paper will be set out of the syllabus for B.Sc. Agriculture/Horticulture or equivalent of GNDU.
7. Practical Test will be based on different kinds of job requirement.
