CATEGORIES FOR COMPETITION

Class – A

Winter Flowers in 3 pots each
Not more than 10 inches size

- A-1 : Aster/ Antirrhinum
- A-2 : Dahlia
- A-3 : Marigold
- A-4 : Pansy
- A-5 : Petunia
- A-6 : Stock/ Salvia
- A-7 : Any Seasonal/other flowers
- A-8 : Display of 8 pots with in any winter flower

Class – B

Foliage /Ornamental plants in 3 pots each
Not more than 15 inches size

- B-1 : Aglaonema/ Asparagus
- B-2 : Coleus/ Crotons
- B-3 : Dieffenbachia
- B-4 : Dracaena
- B-5 : Ferns
- B-6 : Ficus spp.
- B-7 : Palms
- B-8 : Any other plant- not mentioned as above
- B-9 : 3 Containers/Other than pots of plants with any size any variety.
- B-10: Display of 8 Foliage Plants in any variety



Class – C

Cacti and Succulents in 2 pots each
Not more than 10 inches size

- C-1 : Cacti Grafted
- C-2 : Cacti Non-Grafted
- C-3 : Succulents
- C-4 : Display of 5 pots with Cacti and Succulents in any variety

Class – D

Bonsai in pots
Not more than 10 inches size

- D-1 : Collection of two pots in different Bonsai plants
- D-2: Best specimen of Bonsai in Single Pot

Class – E

- E-1 : Display by Nurseries of 20 Pots of flowers in any variety not more than 10 inches.
- E-2: Display of 15 Pots of Ornamental Plants in any variety not more than 15 inches.
- E-3: 3 Containers/Other than pots of plants with any size any variety.

Class – F

Rangoli 4x4 feet size

- F-1 : Rangoli with flowers petals
- F-2 : Rangoli with artificial materials

GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS

1. Competition is open for individuals, institutions, colleges and schools.
2. The exhibits will be admitted without entry fee.
3. Nursery men to display a group of 20 pots of any flower variety under class E-1 and 15 pots of ornamental plants in any variety under class E2.
4. One entry per participant per Section will be allowed.
5. Each Entry must be properly labeled as per the entry form number, Showing class, etc.
6. Any type of marking on the pots shall lead to cancellation of entry.
7. Proper placement of the Pots in respective class is the responsibility of the participants to avoid inconvenience.
8. Efforts will be made for proper care of exhibits; however, the organizers will not be responsible for any damage, hence simple material should be used to display.
9. All exhibits pertaining to competition will be arranged by participant themselves
10. Freshly transplanted plants in pots will not be entertained for competition.
11. Decision of the Judges will be final.
12. The participants will be allowed to take away their exhibits after the prize distribution function i.e. 4:00pm on 19.03.2025 (Wednesday).
