Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Between

National Institute of Urban Affairs, New Delhi

(hereinafter called "NIUA")

Represented by Jagan Shah

Director, NIUA

And

Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP)

Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Punjab

For Academia Engagement on Decentralised Sanitation

This agreement made on the 1st day of October 2018 between National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA), New Delhi through its Director, located at Core-4B, 1st & 2nd Floor, India Habitat Centre, Lodhi Road, New Delhi – 110003 and Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP), Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, through its Vice Chancellor, as part of the Sanitation Capacity Building Platform (SCBP) Project. The project is supported by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

GRDSP will make use of their strength and experience in decentralized sanitation to carry out the activities outlined in the TOR.

It is hereby mutually agreed between NIUA and GRDSP hereto for themselves and their representatives, executors, administrators assign or successors as follows.



TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE MoU

- The term of this Agreement comes into effect on 1st October, 2018 and will remain in force until 31st March 2019 or till the required deliverables under the Terms of Reference (ToR) (Refer Annex 1) are achieved. Extension of time can be sought only with prior approval and mutual consensus.
- Any amendment to this agreement shall be in writing and by mutual consent through an exchange of correspondence between NIUA and GRDSP.
- Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) through its Head of Department and NIUA through its Director will act in line with mutually agreed rules for cooperation and coordination.
- Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) will be responsible for the delivery of activities outlined in the ToR (Refer Annex 1).
- 5. NIUA will facilitate activities necessary to achieve required deliverables outlined in the ToR.
- 6. A national academia meet comprising of institutes engaged with SCBP on decentralized sanitation will be held once every three months for peer learning purpose. Nodal faculty from your institute shall be invited to attend it and share your learnings/feedback. The cost for travel and accommodation for academia meet is budgeted as outlined in ToR (Refer Annex 2).
- Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) shall submit a report highlighting key learnings from conducting all activities under this agreement.
- All knowledge product prepared under SCBP shall be the joint property of Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) and NIUA, and shall have the SCBP and NIUA logo on it along with the logo of Guru Nanak Dev University..

Payment

- 9. I) NIUA shall pay to Guru Ram Das School of Planning(GRDSP) under this MoU a Total amount of INR 415,000 (Four Lakh Fifteen Thousand Rupees) for the implementation of the tasks mentioned in the ToR in accordance with the budget attached as Annexure 2 and this amount is exclusive of service tax (or GST as applicable), which will be paid in addition to this amount.
 - II) However, if NIUA shall bear the costs for providing SCBP partners/experts/resource persons on behalf of Guru Ram Das School of Planning(GRDSP) as outlined in ToR (Refer



Annex 2), it shall be factored in the total payment made by NIUA to Guru Ram Das School of Planning(GRDSP), based on mutual consensus.

III) Payments will be made upon receipt of 'request for payment' form with invoice from Guru Ram Das School of Planning(GRDSP) indicating the tasks completed as per item (V) below. Performa for 'Request for Payment' form is attached with this MoU (Refer Annex 3) IV) The release of payments will be as per the activities and timelines described in (IV) below.

V) The terms and conditions for the release of payments are as follows:

- 50% of total amount on signing of MoU.
- 50% of total amount upon completion of all activities and submission and acceptance by NIUA of the Final Report.

Termination

- 10. I) In the event of cancellation of NIUA's contract agreement with the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, payments will be based on mutual agreement between Guru Ram Das School of Planning(GRDSP) and NIUA reflecting the situation and tasks carried out by Guru Ram Das School of Planning(GRDSP).
 - II) In the event of termination of the MoU for non-submission of report, Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) shall be liable to refund to NIUA the amount proportionate to the tasks remaining to be performed, out of the amount received by Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) of the advance payment of the total amount.

Arbitration

11. Any differences between Parties concerning the interpretation and/or application of this agreement or matters arising out of or connected with this agreement shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiations failing which the parties agree to refer the disputes/difference, if any, to an Arbitrator mutually agreed upon and appointed by the parties under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or its statutory amendments thereof. The venue of arbitration shall be at Delhi alone.



Liability

- 12. NIUA shall not be liable for any damages or compensation payable at law in respect of or in consequence of any accident or injury to any member of staff or other person in the employ of Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) or in relation to the violation of any right of third parties, including but limited to copyrights. By the act of signature of this MoU, Guru Ram Das School of Planning(GRDSP) agrees that NIUA is indemnified and kept indemnified against all such damages and compensation and against all claims, proceedings, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof or in relation thereto. Insurance cover against such liability is Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) responsibility.
- 13. Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) shall indemnify NIUA against all losses and claims in respect of injuries or damage to any person or material or physical damage to any property or to other (intellectual) rights to third parties whatsoever which may arise out of or in consequence of the execution of the project and against all claims, proceedings, damages costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereto. Guru Ram Das School of Planning (GRDSP) is responsible for insuring its own liability.
