## **GURU NANAK DEV UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, JALANDHAR**

**INTRODUCTION** : Started as Panjab University Evening College in 1962, it came under the jurisdiction of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar in 1973 and was renamed after it. The College has been shifted from Basti Nau to Ladowali Road in December 2010. The college is now housed in the majestic building and has a peaceful and conducive environment for study.

Started as an Arts College, it gradually shifted its focus from the traditional to professional courses. MCA (FYIC) was introduced in the session 2002 and MBA (FYIC) was started in the session 2004 to provide better educational and career opportunities to the students. MBA (2 years) was introduced from the session (2010-11) to meet the demands of the students of this region. MCA (3 years) was also introduced by the university from 2012-13 sessions in view of the market needs. With effect from 2013-14 session two undergraduate courses, i.e., B. Com (Regular) and B. Com (Professional) and one post graduate, i.e., M.Com have been added. These courses are running in the morning as well as evening shifts with a view rendering an opportunity for regular education to the working community of the region, thereby making the fullest utilization of the infrastructure possible. With effect from academic session 2014-15, two undergraduate courses i.e. B.C.A and B.B.A. besides one post-graduate course M.Sc (Mathematics) have also been added.
